

STATEMENT OF FAITH:

The Scriptures...

We believe the Bible is the inspired Word of God and is inerrant in the original writings but that it has been edited so that modern versions erase God's Daughter Pele.

We believe that Hawaiian chants reveal Pele's true importance and Her relationship to God as His Daughter. We believe these chants are as accurate and authentic as the Scriptures.

We believe that Scripture is to be taken in its natural and literal sense, recognizing the interpreter must not appeal to literary forms which cast doubt on the reliability or the morality of the Divine Author of Scripture.

The True God...

We believe there is only one living and true God existing as four entities, the Father, the Son, the Daughter, and the Holy Spirit (the Holy Quaternity). We believe that the members of the Godhead have the same nature and attributes and are worthy of the same worship and honor.

We believe that the Father is the source of all things and the One who sent the Son and Daughter as His gifts into the world.

We believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, eternal and equal with the Father, born of the virgin Mary, and that He is both true God and true man. We believe that Jesus Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures as a voluntary and substitutionary sacrifice. We believe that Jesus Christ rose physically from the dead and ascended to the right hand of the Father, where He is now ministering as our advocate and High Priest. We believe that Jesus Christ will receive us unto Himself at His coming and will return to establish His millennial kingdom on earth.

We believe that Pele is the Daughter of God, eternal and equal with her half brother Jesus, born of Haumea, and that She is both true Goddess and true woman. We believe that Pele created the physical earth and continues to do so today through geologic processes that

she controls. We believe that Pele will welcome us into Herself at the Rapture when She and Jesus return to establish Their millennial kingdom on earth in a pi'o marriage.

We believe the Holy Spirit is a divine person who is co-equal with the Father, Son, and Daughter, and that He was active in creation, convicts the world of sin, reveals Christ and Pele, and baptizes all believers into the church at the moment of conversion.
